

# HENRY VIII AND HIS MINISTERS, 1509-40 TIMELINE

1500s

1509 - Henry's accession to the throne

1509 - Wolsey appointed to the Privy Council

1509 - Henry marries Arthur's widow, Catherine of Aragon



1510s

1512 - Henry declares war against France



1513 - Wolsey organises the invasion of France

1514 - Wolsey appointed Archbishop of York

1515 - Wolsey becomes a cardinal and Lord Chancellor of England

1516 - Catherine gives birth to Mary, later Queen Mary Tudor

1514 - Wolsey negotiates peace with France



1516 - Cromwell becomes a member of Wolsey's household

1518 - Treaty of London



1520s

1520 - Field the Cloth of Gold: meeting between Henry and Francis I of France

1521 - Treaty of Bruges with Charles V

1525 - The Amicable Grant

1525 - Resistance in several counties, notably in Suffolk



1526 - The Eltham Ordinances reduces the size of the Privy Council



1528-29 Wolsey and Cardinal Campeggio try the case to annul Henry's marriage with Catherine of Aragon

1526 - Henry falls in love with Anne Boleyn

1529 - Annulment case referred to Rome

1529 - Wolsey dismissed as Lord Chancellor

1529 - Thomas More becomes Chancellor
