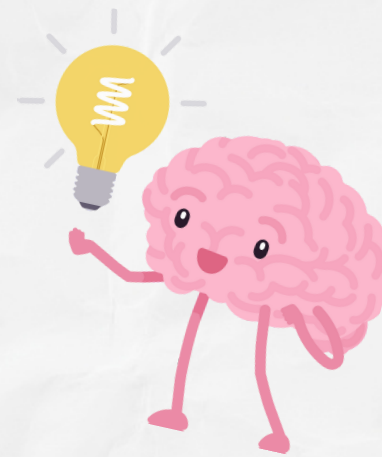


How do I revise History?



Top tips

- Vary your revision methods and take regular breaks
- Keep in mind what you are assessed on - different papers have different question types, so if you know a question on similarity/difference may come up, cover this in your revision
- Revise both content and exam technique

Understand what you are assessed on

Knowledge and understanding - how well do you know the key features and characteristics of each time period?



Explanation and analysis - can you write about change, continuity, similarity, difference, cause, consequence and importance/significance?

Can you analyse, evaluate and use **sources** to make judgements?

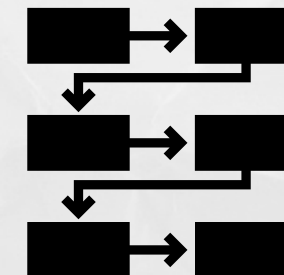


Can you analyse, evaluate and make judgements about **interpretations**? Can you write about why interpretations might differ?

Great for: memorising dates, key facts and statistics

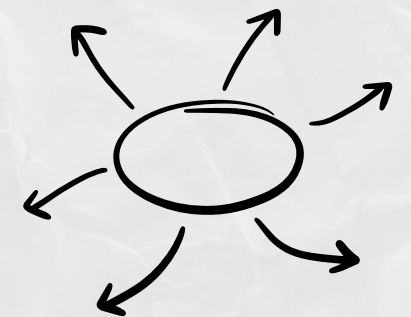


Flowcharts

Great for: tackling narrative questions

Mind maps

Great for: organising ideas, linking topics



Practice paragraphs

Great for: deep-dive into exam technique

Essay plans

Great for: structuring arguments, linking topics



Past papers

Great for: practicing under timed conditions
